



CONCEPCIÓN

Founded in 1989 in Concepción, Universidad San Sebastian has positioned itself as one of the most important universities in the región, the largest among the private universities in terms of number of students and infrastructure built.

Concepción is located 509 kilometers south of Santiago, and is the capital city of the Región del Bío Bío. Including Talcahuano, Penco and other urban areas this city is one of the largest industrial, finance, and demographic conurbations of the country.

Concepción has a mediterranean climate with oceanic influence. The Bío Bío river that crosses the city is one of the few navigable waterway of the country, and it is considered the “main entrance to the South of Chile”. Concepción is famous for the balance of its rural and urban surroundings, its university district, fishing coves, music and cultural scene.

VALDIVIA

The Valdivia headquarters of the San Sebastián University has been characterized from its beginnings by its strong and active involvement with the community, forging bonds with the city through cultural activities such as the Entrepreneurship Fair and the Summer School for senior people.

Valdivia is the capital city of the Región de los Ríos, located 850 kilometers south to Santiago. Named that way after its founder, Pedro de Valdivia, the city is located at the confluence of the Calle-Calle, Valdivia, Cruces, and Cau-Cau rivers.

Surrounded by wetlands and forest, this beautiful city was a strategic fortified spot for the Spanish Empire during the Colony. Today, the valdivian fort system is a popular turistic attraction, enriched by the cultural legacy of German immigrants arrived during the XIX century.

The weather of the Región de los Ríos is oceanic with heavy rains on Winter.




